

### **SHERRIED CHEESECAKE TRIFLE:**

#### **Ingredients:**


750g packaged cream cheese  
4 egg yolks  
 $\frac{3}{4}$  cup castor sugar  
2 teaspoons grated lemon rind  
 $\frac{1}{3}$  cup lemon juice  
 $\frac{3}{4}$  cup milk  
 $\frac{1}{2}$  cup sweet sherry  
375g packaged plain sweet biscuits  
Ground nutmeg  
750g strawberries, halved

#### **Method:**

Have cream cheese at room temperature. Beat cream cheese in a large bowl with electric mixer until smooth, add egg yolks, sugar, lemon rind and lemon juice, beat until combined.

Combine milk and sherry in a bowl. Dip one-third of the biscuits into milk mixture, place over base of large serving dish. Spread one-third of the cream cheese mixture over biscuits, sprinkle with a little nutmeg, top with one-third of the strawberries.

Repeat layering twice, cover; refrigerate overnight.

## **WEDDIN SHIRE COUNCIL NEWS 28/11/2012**

A well represented group of residents attended last week's Council Meeting with permission to address Council. Topics centred around the Quondong Road/Brickfield Road area and included such matters as road markings, speed limits, sealing and garbage collections.

All matters raised were referred for investigation, including possible referral to the Local Traffic Committee and the Town Works Committee.

The presentations were well conducted and councillors were impressed with the enthusiasm of the group.

The same group also submitted a petition seeking the sealing of Brickfield Road. Whilst this would normally be a matter for council only, through the Town Works Committee, some of the reasons advanced related to traffic matters which will be referred to the Police through the Local Traffic Committee.

There were a number of donations approved at the meeting. Firstly, Council resolved to donate \$100 to each of the Shire's six Schools for their annual presentation days.

Secondly, Council resolved to donate 25% of their annual rates to the Grenfell Union Club, in accordance with the usual policy.

Thirdly, Council called for a detailed report before considering a request from the PAH&I Society for a donation towards their sewer rates. This will be re-considered next meeting.

The Iris Group appears to be re-forming, with Council being advised of another 6 volunteers to help Allen Stien up at O'Briens Hill (off O'Brien Street).

Allen and Gloria have been struggling to keep things going over the last few years and they will certainly appreciate the extra help.

The Henry Lawson Festival Committee would also appreciate some volunteers to fill some key positions including the all important secretary's role. President John Hunter has got his committee and coordinators all moving in the right direction after a very successful 2012 Festival, but they certainly need help for the 2013 Festival. If you can help, or you and a friend can job-share, please let John know: he is waiting for your call.

The Festival committee prepared a business plan in 2010 with the help of consultant John Allen. The business plan is due to be reviewed at the Festival's December meeting which has been brought forward to 11<sup>th</sup> to facilitate this work. John Allen will attend this meeting to prepare the necessary update.

Past and present members are welcome to contribute.

Nominations for the annual Australia Day Awards close this Friday 30<sup>th</sup>. If you know of someone who has made an exceptional contribution to the community or the Shire, please submit a nomination so that their contribution can be publicly acknowledged.

Council's Annual Report for 2011/2012 has been completed and will shortly be available on the website. A supplementary State of Environment Report accompanies this report.

The annual Financial Report has been prepared and is currently undergoing audit. Once accepted the Statements will be placed on public exhibition before being formally presented to Council's December Meeting.


