### **COLESLAW WITH CRAISINS**

Preparation: 20 minutes

Serves: 4-6

½ savoy cabbage, trimmed and finely shredded\*  
1 carrot, peeled and coarsely grated  
2 green onions (shallots), trimmed and thinly sliced  
½ cup raisins, chopped  
½ cup reduced fat coleslaw dressing  
Salt and ground black pepper.

*\*You will require about 4 cups of shredded cabbage.*

1. Place cabbage, carrot, green onions and raisins in a bowl. Drizzle with coleslaw dressing and season with salt and pepper. Toss to combine and serve.

#### **Serving suggestions:**

- Serve on a burger or with a barbequed sausage on a bread roll.
- Serve in a bread wrap with shaved ham or chicken.
- Serve with fish and chips.



#### **Savoy Cabbage**

- ✓ *An excellent source of vitamin C, which helps protect the body against infections.*
- ✓ *A good source of dietary fibre, which helps keep us regular.*
- ✓ *The darker the leaves, the higher the vitamin content.*

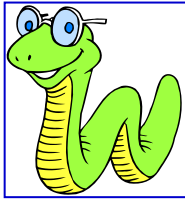

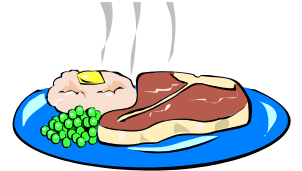
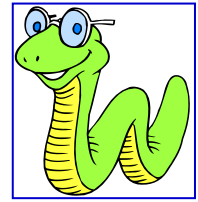
