COLESLAW WITH CRAISINS

Preparation: 20 minutes Serves: 4-6

½ savoy cabbage, trimmed and finely shredded*
1 carrot, peeled and coarsely grated
2 green onions (shallots), trimmed and thinly sliced
½ cup craisins, chopped
½ cup reduced fat coleslaw dressing
Salt and ground black pepper.

* You will require about 4 cups of shredded cabbage.

1. Place cabbage, carrot, green onions and craisins in a bowl. Drizzle with coleslaw dressing and season with salt and pepper. Toss to combine and serve.

- Serve on a burger or with a barbequed sausage on a bread roll.
- Serve in a bread wrap with shaved ham or chicken.
- Serve with fish and chips.




