Choosing school shoes





MINI CHOCOLATE FRUIT CAKE PUDDINGS

The kids will love them as well and are perfect for end of school break up party or Christmas party or to box up as a gift.

1 Fruit Cake purchased from the Lions Club. (Please see previous Lions Advertisement or contact Rob Maslin to purchase one)

250 grams Eating chocolate. (Melted) Melted white chocolate to decorate Spearmint leaves. (Lollies) Glazed Cherries.

- 1. Simply crush the fruit cake into a large bowl until all the larger chunks are broken into small pieces.
- 2. Pour in the melted chocolate and mix well to combine.
- 3. Take tablespoon amounts of the mixture and roll into balls. Place onto a small patty pan. Repeat until all mixture is used.
- 4. Place in fridge to set.
- 5. To decorate, melt white chocolate and drizzle over the top. Place Spearmint Iollies and glazed cherries on to.


