MINI MARS BAR CHRISTMAS PUDDINGS

.200 grams Mars Bars, Chopped
2 tablespoon of pouring (thin) cream
2 teaspoons cocoa powder, sifted
3 cups rice bubbles
Canola Spray
100 grams white chocolate
24 Christmas M&Ms

Spray a little canola spray into 2 x 12 cup mini muffin trays. Melt the mars bars, cream and cocoa in a glass bowl over simmering water. The bowl should not touch water. Stir the mixture until smooth. Put rice bubbles in a separate large bowl, pour in the chocolate mixture and stir until well mixed. Spoon the mixture into muffin trays and press down gently. Refrigerate for 2 hours then turn out onto a tray to decorate, Melt white chocolate add one teaspoon to the top of each pudding and place a M&M on top.






