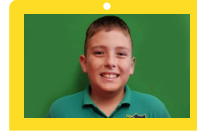
From the K-2 Room

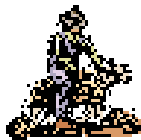
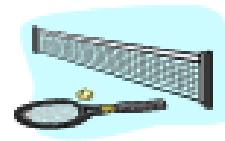
