Morning tea will be provided.

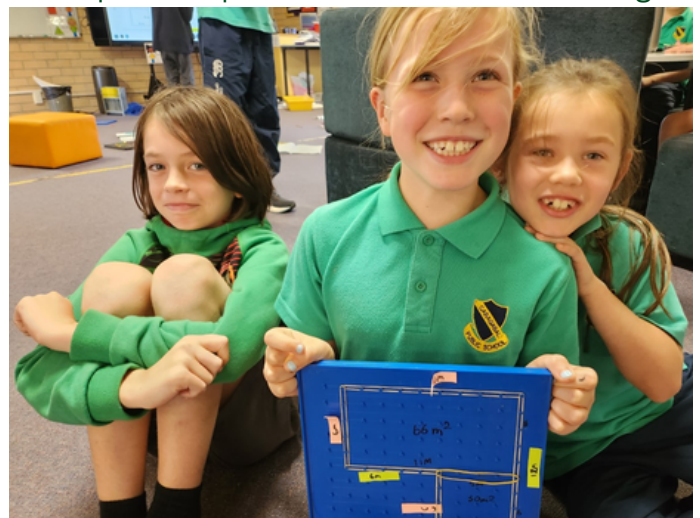
Following on from morning tea we will be holding a School Assembly in the School Library at 10:00am.

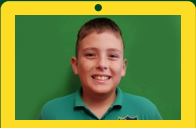
The leadership team will be running the assembly and parents are invited to attend.

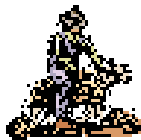
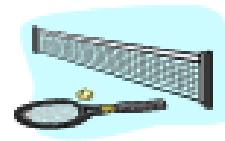
