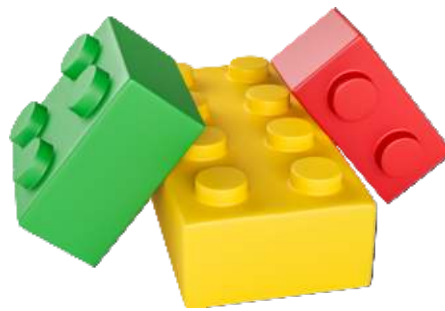

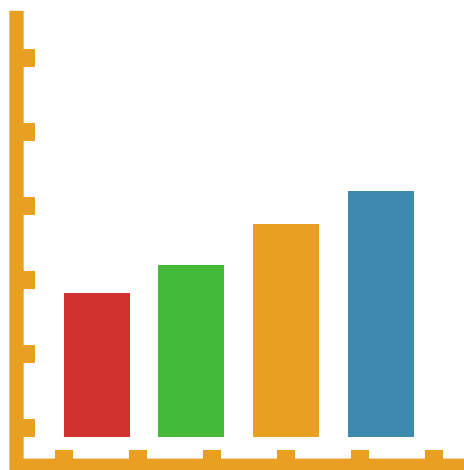

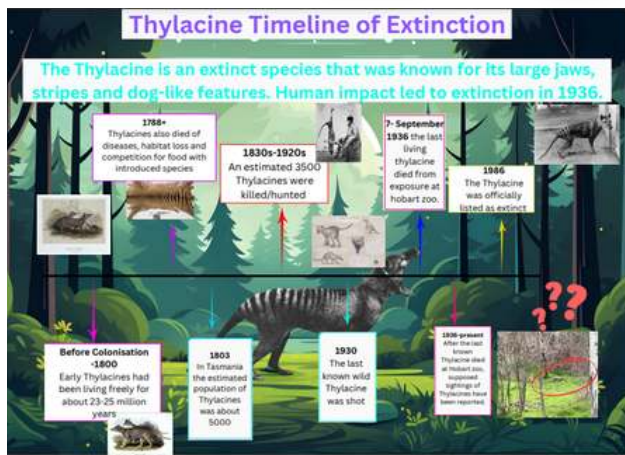

## Creating data graphs in Maths using Lego bricks

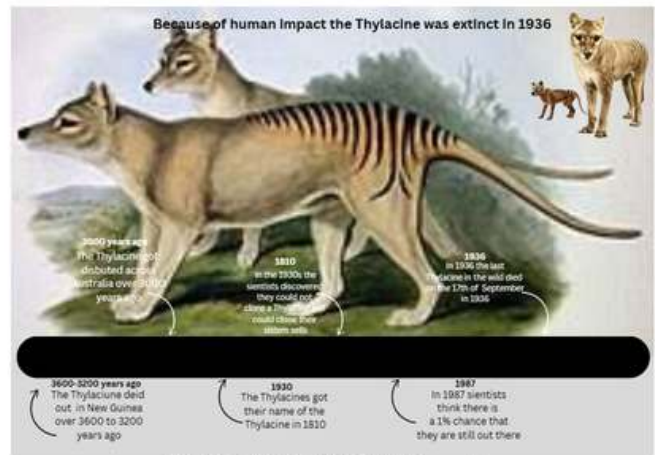

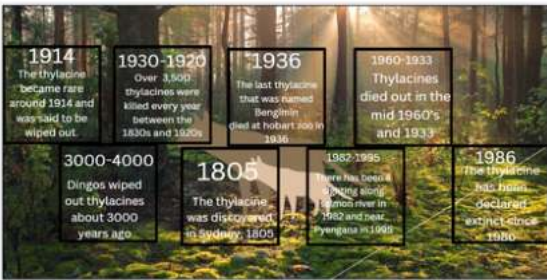


Thylacine Timeline by Emily Mastin & April Cooper

The Potatoes class have been working on a Timeline of Extinction on the Thylacine using the Canva program.

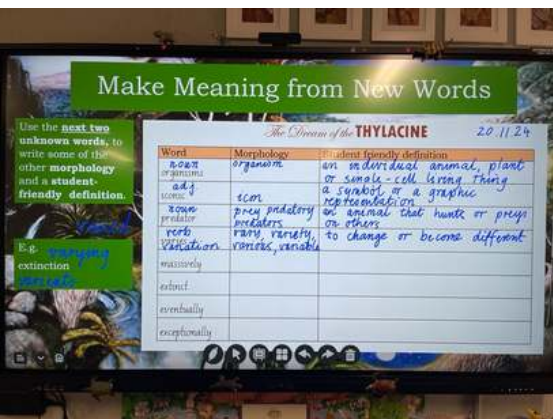


Thylacine Timeline by Indi Ridley

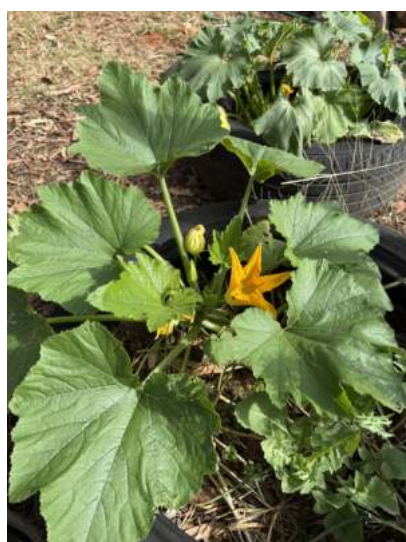
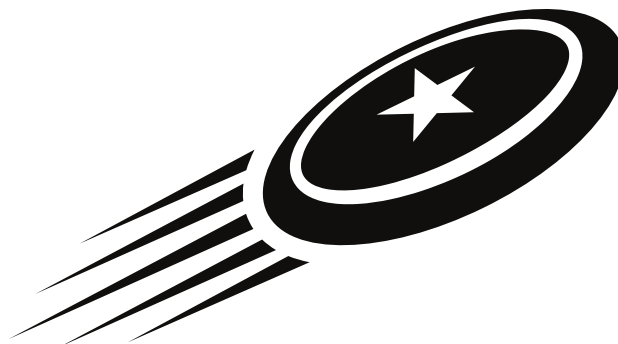


## **Nic Sport report**

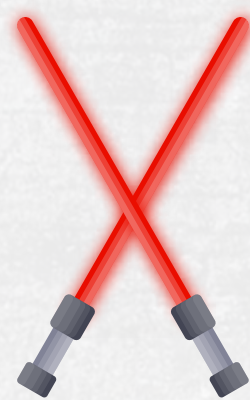
